Great news! Our 2022/23 Mesa Thrives fundraising drive has officially covered the cost of all four paraprofessionals that provide our students with exceptional individualized learning. Thank you again to our amazing Mesa community for your generous donations!

While Mesa Thrives funds are allocated directly to fund paraprofessionals, funds raised by the PTO from its activities, such as Fall Fest, community nights, and store give-back programs are directed to support student success at Mesa and a thriving school for all.

In the event that Mesa Thrives were to fall short of the needed fundraising for our paraprofessionals, this additional money would go towards that need.

In past years, additional PTO funds have gone to programs such as replacing Chromebooks (the district allocation is short of the level desired by our teachers), purchasing stands for the auditorium, and training teachers in the Orton Gillingham (OG) literacy methods.
