  - Mesa will need a replacement rep
- At meetings: Superintendent, CTO, head of curriculum
  - General council showed up at a meeting
- Best conduit/direct line to the super & C-suite people
- 2nd Wednesday of each month, from 6:30-8:30

# **Budget Update from Anna**

- Not much change since last month
- Got another corporate match from Benevity
- Have funds in excess of \$39-\$40K of budget, still need to carry over 20% though
  - We write the last big check for the paras at the end of May
- By-laws for excess funds state we need to fill out a PTO Funding Request form
  - Anna passed around the form for everyone to review
  - People can fill out hard copies (available at the office) or on line (available on the Mesa PTO website)
  - Mesa teachers, staff and community can submit suggestions any time of year
  - Anna will also bring copies of the form to every PTO meeting
- When filling out a PTO Funding Request keep in mind things like:
  - Does it affect only one grade?
  - Is it an improvement for years to come, or just one year?
  - We want to provide things for the school as a whole rather than to a set group of students
- PTO will have a twice annual call for ideas on ways the PTO can vote on spending any remaining budget (if there is any) in the Spring and Fall
- Per Kristen, in the past we've made the spending allocation decision close to the end of May to ensure that we have enough funds to cover the paras
- Mesa Thrives covers paraprofessionals
  - If we don't have enough through Thrives to cover paras, then other events like Fall Fest will be needed to help cover
- New ideas to consider
  - Josh and April raised the need for math enrichment/support due to Covid
  - April proposed a Decodables reading need for K-2

#### Fundraising committee for Thrives

• Next year's fundraising committee (Thrives) will have its own committee

- Please volunteer to be on the committee
- 1st meeting this spring, won't meet over the summer but will hit the ground running in the fall
- Big need for classroom ambassadors that would engage/email with other parents in the class on Mesa Thrives
  - Ideally representing each class or grade level
  - This role made a big difference and each time these people would engage,
    Mesa saw a bump in funds
- Pete has volunteered to lead the Thrives committee again for at least one more year
  - He mentioned it would be good to start training someone

## <u>DEI</u>

- Update on DEI event Youth Equity Council
  - Good number of attendees from 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> grade, a few younger students as well
  - Kids on council related personal experiences
  - Carrie appreciates the work of Christine, Sarah, and the DEI meeting committee
  - If you liked the event, feel free to let BVSD know
- End of April there will be another DEI event around Neurodiversity

### Multicultural event update by Anna

- Meeting today at 2 PM, event on May 11
- Still need a few more families to volunteer to host tables
  - Feel free to send an email to the PTO board if you are considering an idea for a table but are unsure
  - We all have culture and we all want our kids to be proud of their culture
    - Doesn't have to just be families with an international parent
- Open to other cultures that families identify with: sports, cultural activities, music, etc; ie culture of Boulder
- Two food trucks are coming
- Will have an event during the school day to create enthusiasm for the evening event
- Another Friday Folder reminder would be helpful to remind families
  - Share the list of what families are doing?

### Principal's Report

- On pace to have most attendance at PTO meetings this year
- Some children are participating in "Arts from the Heart" after school
  - Today there will be an unveiling at King Soopers of a permanent installation in memoriam of the KS shooting two years ago
  - Side note there is a great art installation at the district offices
- Need someone to run for School Board
  - We are losing our South Boulder school board representative, Kathy Gephardt
  - Need a South Boulder candidate to run to replace her
- 52 days of school left this year, almost 30% of the school year to go

- FET continues to work on FAQ
  - Especially helpful for new families or if you're not familiar with how things work in elementary school
  - o Amabel has more information on this if folks are interested
- Long-range advisory committee
  - Makes recommendations around enrollment in BVSD
  - Strongly focused on enrollment, meet monthly, Josh is part of committee
  - No proposals yet to the board
  - Timeline is June to make recommendations to the school board on the things to consider around the long term implications of enrollment and what the school board needs to consider
- BVSD has enough money in the budget to support the smaller schools that because of their fixed costs tend to be a bit more expensive, no fiscal cliff in the next few years
  - Coming up with plans as to when schools need to be evaluated, list of criteria that if school meets XYZ, then look for creative solutions
  - Mike reiterated that BVSD board has said our budget is in good shape, not like
    JeffCo which had major budget issues, BVSD is years away from that issue
  - State statute, have to provide open enrollment
    - A school can get capped, has ebbed and flowed in BVSD over the years
    - Largely in BVSD it's go wherever you want to go
- Amabel is on the District Accountability Committee some recommendations will be coming around open enrollment, some with an equity lens, but also other recommendations

### Eldorado Spring Water

### Mesa Oasis

- Sunny provided an update
- Idea is to repurpose the abandoned garden area and make it a multi-purpose space, for lunches, outdoor classes, general meetings
- Sunny & Josh met with Senior city planner (Mark) and education manager for city of Boulder
  - Those two felt it was a great idea, Mark is a landscape architect and is going to give ideas
- Sunny & Josh got connected E movement (education, environment), Green school yards program
  - BVSD has a mandate that by 2026 have to invested in outdoor spaces, integrate outdoors with education - budget is \$2000/school
    - Josh found out today the facilities person for BVSD, no limits on what PTO can do with the exception that we need to go through a landscaper conjunction on an approved vendor list with BVSD (ie a bonded landscaper)
    - We can acknowledge their support with signage/plaque
